Our affiliation with the Local Area Health Service highlights a dual aim of attracting current and future medical leaders to the region, and in turn improving the provision of health care to the Greater Western Sydney community.

This position will be principally located at Campbelltown Hospital but also with access to the state of the art teaching and research facilities at the Campbelltown Campus. The Senior Lecturer in Diabetes Medicine will contribute to teaching, research, and administration in the School of Medicine. The appointee will be committed to the education of future medical practitioners, and will contribute to the discipline of Medicine locally and internationally.

The successful candidate will be involved in the delivery of Health Care at Campbelltown Hospital which will involve clinical and administrative responsibilities within the Medicine Unit as directed by the Professor of Medicine. The challenges of this role will include working across both the University and Health Service where the incumbent will have clinical responsibilities.
