

Neo Mercazole approved for supply under S19A of the Therapeutic Goods Act

Link Medical Products would like to advise that due to an ongoing shortage of carbimazole 5mg tablets, and to maintain supply, the TGA has granted approval to supply an alternative product until **30 November 2014**, under subsection 19A of the Therapeutic Goods Act, 1989, the *Act*.

Approval has been granted to supply product which is approved in New Zealand. This is called **Neo-Mercazole 5mg tablets**, and while this product has the same active ingredient, carbimazole, as the regular Australian product it is NOT registered in Australia.

As the product is unregistered, the Australian Registration number, AUST R, which is printed on this product's label, has been struck out in such a way that the number of tablets remains clear. The label carries the Australian sponsor's name and address.

Study of doctors' knowledge of transsexual and transgender (trans) health -- volunteers needed

Dear Colleagues,

I am an epidemiologist working in the area of transsexual and transgender (trans) health at The University of Western Australia (UWA).

Trans people are a stigmatised population that experience substantial health disparity. In particular, trans people experience high rates of mental health problems, such as depression and anxiety disorders. Improving our understanding of this population and their relationship with health professionals is important.

I am leading a research team that has been funded by the Western Australian Mental Health Commission to investigate what general practitioners (GPs) know about trans people. The team comprises researchers from the School of Medicine and Pharmacology at UWA, and from the School of Public Health at Curtin University.

However, before we can begin the study, we need to pilot-test our questionnaire with a group of volunteer doctors.

We are looking for volunteers to complete a short, Internet-based multiple-choice questionnaire. The questionnaire will take about 5-10 minutes to complete. After approximately two weeks, we will ask you to take the questionnaire once more. This will help us to assess the reliability of our instrument.

Volunteers must be either:

- a medical doctor (other than a GP) practising in Western Australia; or,

- a medical doctor of any speciality practising in any state other than Western Australia.

Can you help? If you are able to help us with this project, please send an e-mail to <u>zoe.hyde@uwa.edu.au</u>, and we will respond with instructions on how to complete the questionnaire.
