ESA Clinical Weekend 2014, 23-25 August, Peppers The Sands, Torquay, Victoria

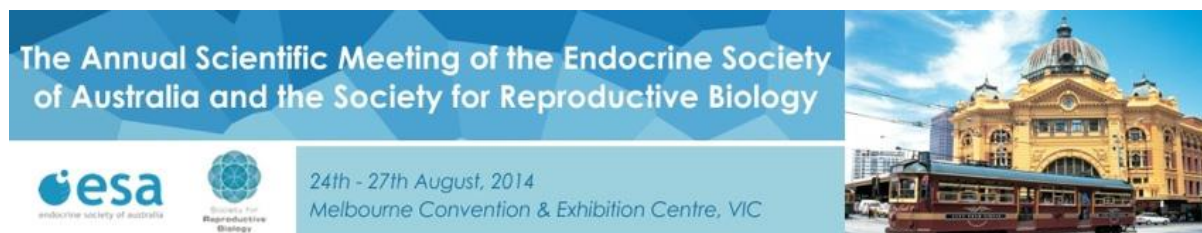
