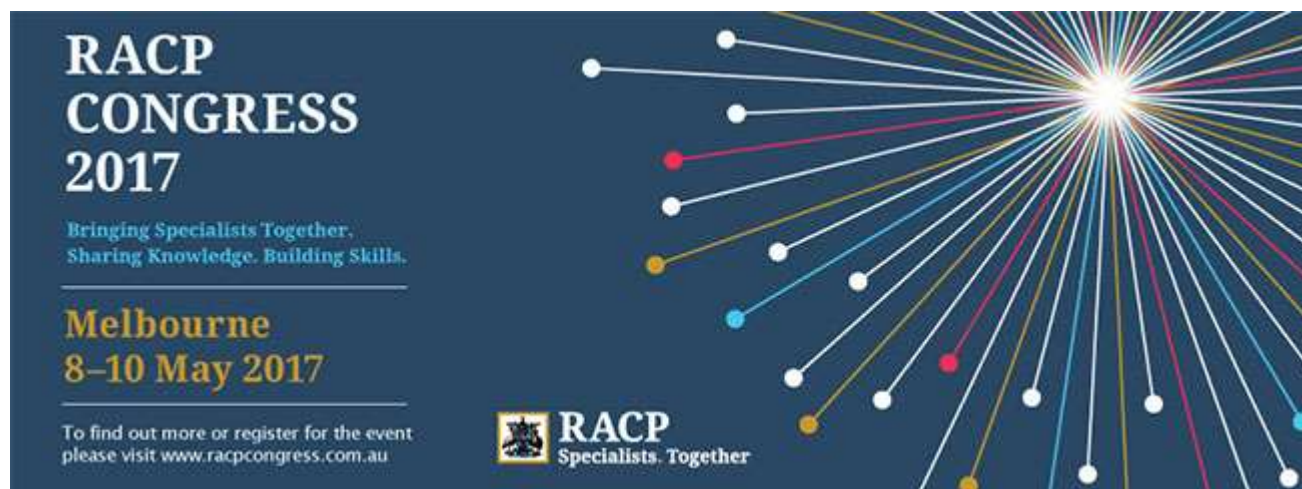
ANNOUNCING ICE 2018 PROGRAM ORGANISING COMMITTEE
