A working group from the Endocrine Society of Australia and Australasian Paediatric Endocrine Group in conjunction with pharma have submitted an application for a listing for growth hormone treatment of severe adult growth hormone deficiency on the Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme. Submissions from the public are invited by the Pharmaceutical Benefits Advisory Committee and may strengthen the application.
