Endocrinology advanced trainees are invited to submit cases for presentation in Torquay at the ESA Clinical Weekend meeting to be held 22-24 August 2014

The submission period is now open. **Closing date for submission is 16 May 2014.**

We are particularly interested in pituitary and bone cases to reflect the interests of our international guest speakers, but all interesting diabetes and endocrine cases will be considered.

Put your imaginations and excellent writing skills to the test! This year we are requesting submission of each case to be in two versions: a short version and a more detailed version. We are hoping to maximize the value of the oral presentation by whetting the appetite with the short version published in the conference booklet, without giving everything away. We hope to avoid the situation where half the audience has already read the full details of the case and all the discussion before the oral presentation, potentially reducing the impact of the presentation and stifling audience participation. The longer detailed version will be provided as a handout at the end of your presentation, enabling delegates to take it away and read at their convenience.

Both the abbreviated and the detailed versions will help the committee decide which cases are selected for oral presentations.

Submissions are to consist of:

1. One A4 page which presents the case and important results, without giving away the whole diagnosis and any special twists. This page will be published in the abstract book. Discussion and literature review is **not** to be part of this document. **Please give the case an interesting title and list your name and at least one supervisor as co-author, who must have discussed the case with you and approved the submission**, along with your department/unit and hospital address and your email address.
2. A detailed presentation of the case, all relevant laboratory and medical imaging findings and a review of the literature. Several take home messages (dot points) should be provided at the end of this document. References (10 maximum) should be cited. This section must not exceed 5 pages (12pt font, regular borders), most cases will be 2-3 pages. The same title, authors, department/unit and address details should be used as for the single A4 page.

For the first time this year, if your case is selected for presentation, a pdf copy of your powerpoint presentation will be made available to registered delegates following the meeting. By submitting your case you are agreeing to this.

Additionally, if your case is selected for presentation you will be entitled to a discounted open access publication in Endocrinology, Diabetes & Metabolism Reports, an Endocrine Society of Australia- endorsed online resource. You can publish your full case report for just AUD\$377 (standard fee AUD\$472). More details are on the clinical weekend website under the EDM Case Reports tab.

The outcome of submissions will be notified at the start of June 2014.
